Chopta Tungnath & Chandrashila Trek is the entire area comes under <u>Kedarnath</u> musk deer sanctuary, District Rudraprayag Uttarakhand, Chopta at an approximate altitude of 2,608 m) so chances are that you can spot wildlife including wild goat and Himalayan monal in the morning.

Most popularly known as the 'Mini Switzerland' of Uttarakhand, Himalayas.

- Chopta: Chopta is a small village located at an altitude of 2680 meters above sea level and serves as the base camp for several treks in the region. It is surrounded by forests of rhododendron, deodar, and pine trees and offers stunning views of the Himalayan peaks like Nanda Devi, Trishul, and Chaukhamba. The trek to Chopta is a relatively easy one and is suitable for beginners.
- Sari Village: Sari Village is a small village located at the base of the Deoriatal trek. It is a popular starting point for the trek and offers stunning views of the Himalayan peaks. The trek from Sari Village to Deoriatal is a relatively easy one and takes around 2-3 hours.
- Chandrashila Peak: Chandrashila Peak is a summit located at an altitude of 3965 meters above sea level and offers stunning views of the Himalayan peaks like Nanda Devi, Trishul, and Chaukhamba. The trek to Chandrashila Peak is a challenging one and involves steep ascents and descents. However, the stunning views from the summit make it all worth it.

- Altitude, approximate altitude of 2,608 m; Chopta is 212km from Haridwar.
- You will be picked up sharp at 6:30 AM from Haridwar/Rishikesh
- It is going to be a long drive of almost 10-11 hours, so get prepared accordingly.
- In Joshimath, you will get the last ATM point.
- You will not face any networks problem all along the way
- Night stay will be scheduled in a swiss tent with shared accommodation at Chopta.





- Chandrashila peak 3,683 Meters, 12,083 ft) back to camp (08 km) (6/7 Hours)
- Trek from Chopta to Tungnath Temple 4km. time taken to 3 to 4 hours.
- From Tungnath to Chandrashila peak 1.5km. trek and return Chopta.
- After Lunch Same day drive to Sari village from Chopta.
- Overnight stay in the swiss tent in triple and qured sharing basis.






- Early morning Sari to Deorital Trek.

- You will reach at Haridwar/Rishikesh between 8:30 to 9:30 pm.
























Day 1- Pickup to you from Haridwar railway station morning at 7:30 am — Drive to Chopta Camp — 202 Km (7/8 Hours (2,012 Meters) overnight stay camp

Day 3 - Sari village to Deorital explore the valley and back to road head same day Drive from Sari to

Rishikesh.







- Start your trek after having breakfast, the trail from Sari is well-defined, it is maintained and is made up of rocks when you go further you can see some houses and a temple on the way. After some time the trail will get steep and when you go higher you can have a glance of Chandrashila Peak and Tungnath temple as the forest is cleared. As you go higher on the mountain you will see a Hawa Ghar made up by
- the forest department, so that people going higher can relax there and can enjoy the views from there so you can rest there for some tim and relish the beauty of that place. Now, the trail is covered by Rhododendrons and Maple trees, walk under the shade of trees, continue walking, you will get some valley views as you come nearer to your destination. Walk downhill and you will reach Deoria Tal, you can see the flowers blooming, birds chirping as there are a variety of Himalayan birds there. Alluring greenery will relax your mind. Drive from to Hariv (220 km) (7/8 Hours) you will reach Haridwar between 8:30 pm to 9:30 pm. Chopta to Haridwar usually takes around 7-8 hours by car. The
- route passes through scenic landscapes and offers several opportunities to stop and enjoy the views. Here are some of the highlights of the return journey: Ukhimath: Ukhimath is a small town located en route from Chopta to Rishikesh.
